Cargo that exceeds the permissible height, width, and/or length limits. Out of gauge cargo requires special permits and special chassis equipment.
P-Check	Physical Check. This is a check to see that the actual container or cargo was received or delivered. At this time other information such as damages and numbers can also be verified.
